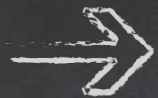
Complex Vocabulary

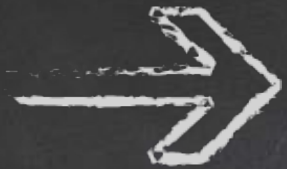

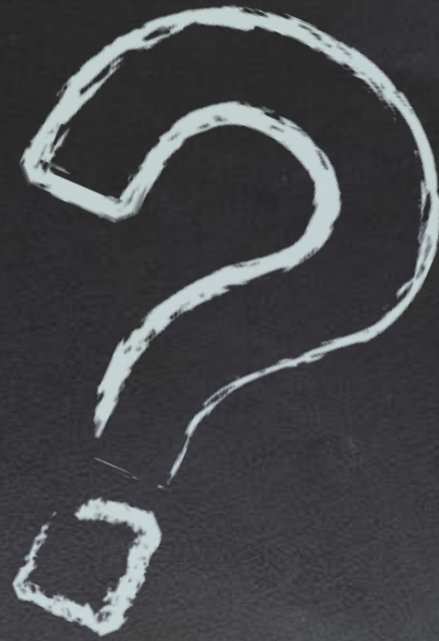
