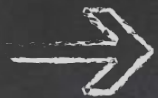
Complex Vocabulary

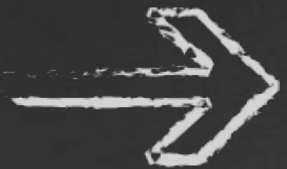
Language Routes for New York

Professional Certificate

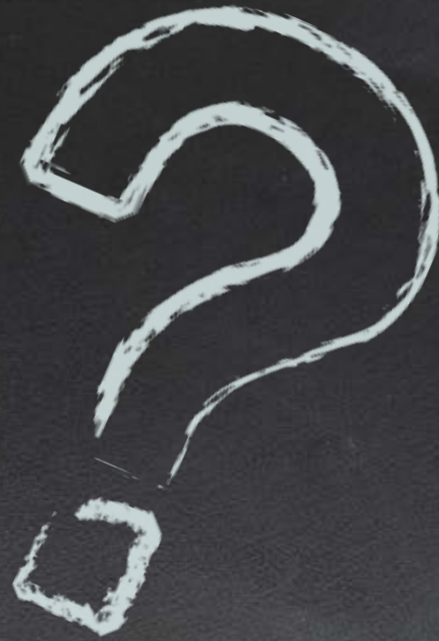


Transitional B Certificate
