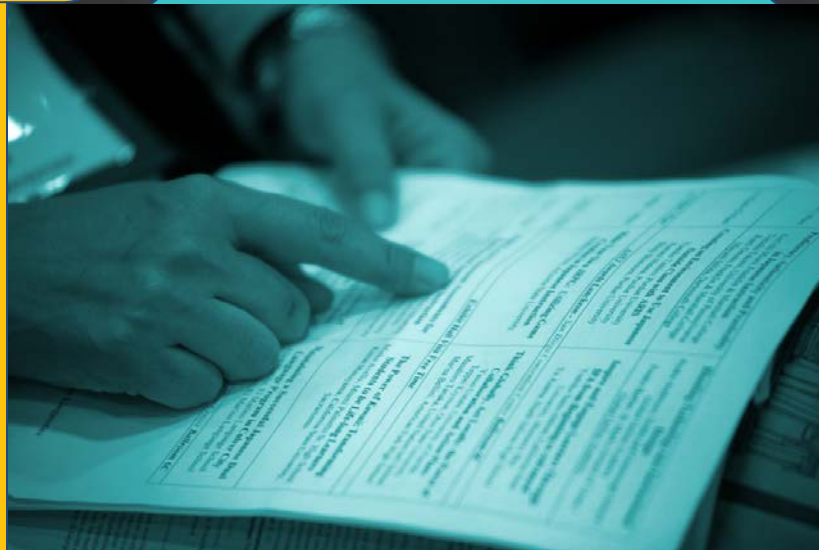

RI values teacher, building administrator, and support professional effectiveness. Due to this commitment, certification **regulations** [PDF] align certification with student achievement and other evidence of effective performance.

Online renewal and progression of certificates is the most user friendly option and may be found on eCert by logging onto **RIDEmap**. To understand whether or not your certificate qualifies for progression, review the **progression and renewal categories**.

- **Current RI educators** may access their certificates through **My eCert** via **RIDEMAP**, RIDE's online certification system. Review the **eCert brochure** [PDF] for more information.
- **The public** may access work assignment and credentials held by RI teachers, administrators, and support professionals on the **Public Educator Verification Portal**.

The **RI Emergency Certification Report** [PDF, 94KB] summarizes data on the issuance and renewal of emergency certificates in the state for the past three school years. The data includes certificate areas totals as well as a listing of districts requesting and employing higher numbers of educators working with an emergency certificate. The data is being shared for transparency purposes. RIDE encourages readers to review the data to consider implications for their own work as educators, leaders, and learners.

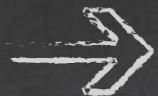
Complex Vocabulary

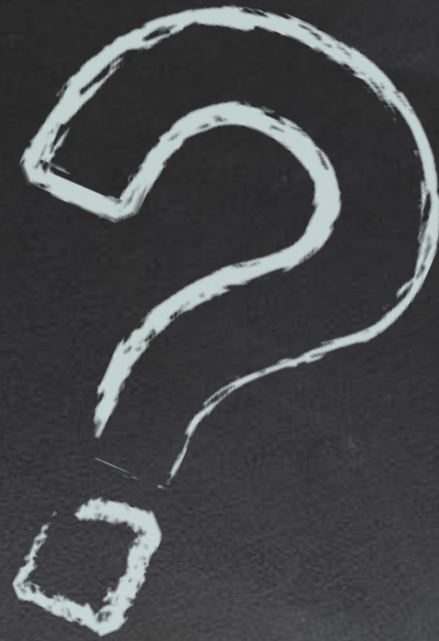
